BRITISH SPARKLING

- 19 VELFREY CUVÉE RESERVE, VELFREY VINEYARD, PEMBROKESHIRE, WALES. 2020 £13 125ml
Produced from a blend of Seyval Blanc and Pinot Noir grapes, followed by 36 months on lees. Real delicate fine mousse, with notes of orange blossom, white fruit, honey melon, and freshly baked brioche.
- 32 ROSÉ, SINGLE VINEYARD, EXTON PARK, HAMPSHIRE, ENGLAND, UK £15 125ml
Precisely ripened Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes, this wine is fragrant with rich fruit characters. Strawberry liquorice nose, with notes of white peach, rose petal and plum.

WHITE

- 254 PAPARUDA FETEASCA REGALA, ESTATE SELECTION, RECAS, ROMANIA, 2024 £9 175ml
Aromatic nose with distinct peach and apricot flavours on the palate, soft and creamy fruit and good dry finish.
- 103 BALFOUR ALBARINO, BALFOUR WINERY, HUSH HEATH ESTATE, KENT, ENGLAND. 2022 £11 175ml £36 500ml
Believed to only be the third Albarino produced in the UK so far! Fresh, fragrant, and zesty, with a slight saline minerality, and real citrus profile. Waxy lemons, white peach, and floral hints.
- 151 PINOT GRIGIO, TERRAZE DELLA LUNA, CAVIT TRENTO, TRENTO, ITALY 2023 £ 11 175ml £ 36 500ml
Pale lemon in colour with clean, floral nose. The palate shows further delicate yet complex floral notes and some nice white fruit with fresh acidity on the finish and rich oily texture.
- 126 LES VOLETS CHARDONNAY, HAUTE VALÉE DE L'AUDE, FRANCE, 2022 £ 12 175ml £ 38 500ml
80% of this Chardonnay is fermented in stainless steel and 20% in old oak for well textured, succulent style with a subtly savoury finish. Bright acidity with green apples and brioche notes with hazelnut twist from the oak barrels.
- 136 LE 'C' DE SEC DU CHATEAU CLOSIOT, BARSAC BLANC, BORDEAUX. FRANCE. 2023 £14 175ml £40 500ml
100% Semillon, produced from late harvest, almost over ripe grapes. Rich, yet dry with a complex palate, and lovely length and creamy texture to finish. Packed with flavour and intensity, of ripe orchard fruits, lemon, baked pear, followed by rich toasty oak, vanilla and spice.

Produced from the three traditional champagne varieties (Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay), a still rosé brimming with delicious summer berry and a zesty freshness, and notes of summer fruits.

Great induction to Valpolicella region. Easy-going flavour profile bursting with luscious dark fruit and hints of dried figs, raising and prunes.
- 527 FRANKENSTEIN PINOTAGE, RADFORD DALE, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA. £14 175ml
Rich blackcurrant and cherry aromas. On the palate, there are intense dark fruit flavours that combine well with a touch of sweet oak. £40 500ml
- 476 MARQUÉS DE ZEARRA, RIOJA GRAN RESERVA, BODEGA PETRALANDA, RIOJA, SPAIN. 2014 £16 175ml
£45 500ml
A complex bouquet of hedgerow fruit with hints of coffee and vanilla and a full-bodied palate of damson with herbal undertones leading to a lingering finish.
- 555 FRANKOVKA BLAUFRANKISH, ZSOLT SUTO, STREKOV, SLOVAKIA. 2022 £20 175ml
Produced from the native grape Blaufrankish, this wine is packed with dark berry characteristics, bramble and pine forest. Deep concentration, but soft, Silky smooth tannins, making this appear lighter. £57 500ml

Red apple characters dominate, along with ripe black and red fruits not often seen in traditional method sparkling wines. The fruit flavours combine wonderfully with an underlying creamy finish and fabulous hint of sweetness. | £68 |

| 14 | RB32 BRUT, SINGLE VINEYARD, EXTON PARK, HAMPSHIRE, ENGLAND. NV
A generous nose and a bright lemony character with notes of passion fruit and honey. Beautiful minerality in the mouth, and a lengthy finish with a whisper of white pepper. | £85 |
| 16 | BLANC DE NOIRS, ANCRE HILL ESTATES, MONMOUTHSHIRE, WALES. NV
Crisp and fresh on the palate with red berry fruit and a hint of gooseberry. Lovely balance of acidity with a lingering finish. An exceptional wine from Wales. | £98 |
| 17 | RB45 BLANC DE BLANCS, SINGLE VINEYARD, EXTON PARK, HAMPSHIRE, ENGLAND. NV
Vibrant tropical and citrus fruit, with subtle notes of vanilla and orange blossom. From the first sip an incredible flinty smokiness leads to a rounded, complex and savoury finish. | £103 |

Crisp green apple, intense grassy and elderflower nose and a splash of rose and citrus spice. Delicious, bright acidity balanced by a smoky depth. An intense, bright aftertaste.
- 101 BALFOUR SKYE'S CHARDONNAY, BALFOUR WINERY, HUSH HEATH ESTATE, KENT. ENGLAND. 2022 £44
Clean citrus driven palate with notes of lime and melon rind. A delightful, aromatic and complex Chardonnay, unoaked, Chablis style.
- 102 HORSMONDEN DRY WHITE, DAVENPORT VINEYARDS, EAST SUSSEX, ENGLAND. 2022 £56
Predominantly produced from the Bacchus grape, Bacchus is a grape almost identical to Sauvignon Blanc, however, it is resistant to frost, therefore able to grow widely in the UK. Classical flavours of elderflower, apple and gooseberry, along with peach, floral notes.
- 103 BALFOUR ALBARINO, BALFOUR WINERY, HUSH HEATH ESTATE, KENT, ENGLAND. 2022 £57
Believed to only be the third Albarino produced in the UK so far! Fresh, fragrant, and zesty, with a slight saline minerality, and real citrus profile. Waxy lemons, white peach, and floral hints.
- 105 BACCHUS / ORTEGA, NATALIA HARRIS WINE, WESTFIELD, EAST SUSSEX, ENGLAND. 2022 £66
Smooth and clean, with tropical and grapefruit aromas, followed by citrus, tropical, green apple on the palate. The label of this wine was created by the world-famous illustrator Quentin Blake, very local to the vineyard.

Light, fresh and elegant with just a touch of weight. The finish is long with delightful flavours of pear and verbena.

80% of this Chardonnay is fermented in stainless steel and 20% in old oak for well textured, succulent style with a subtly savoury finish. Bright acidity with green apples and brioche notes with hazelnut twist from the oak barrels.
- 127 MUSCADET SÈVRE ET MAINE, CHATEAU DE POYET, LOIRE VALLEY. 2019 £48
Extended lees ageing gives this wine added depth and complexity, while remaining fresh and zesty.

Produced predominantly from the native Rabigato grape, with a small blend of Sercial and Viosinho grapes. Vibrant, bright freshness on the nose with yellow and green hues and intense mineral aromas. The palate retains that freshness whilst undergoing a period of 9 months on lees and aging in French Oak, gives great depth and concentration. | £148 |

Attractive ripe green apple and pear aromas. The palate has a fresh acid structure and liveliness, with purity of fruit and spicy nuances. | £67 |

- 202 IM PFARRGARTEN RIESLING FEINHERB, WEINGUT AJ ADAM, MOSEL. 2014 £62
Complex aromas of lime, grapefruit and white spice. Abundant citrus characters on the palate combined with crisp, zesty acidity, and a creamy yet refreshing finish.
- 203 ESCHERNDORFER MÜLLER THURGAU 'S' TROCKEN, WEINGUT HORST SAUER, FRANKEN. 2022 £50
Bright floral and ripe apple aromas, with stone fruit, a gentle touch of spice. The palate is rounded, textured and very long.
- 204 RIESLING KABINETT, REICHSGARF VON KESSELSTATT, BROCKSTEIN, SAAR. 2021 £67
Off-dry style, intense ripe fruits, with a lingering palate. Densely textured with lush, honeyed fruits, notes of gingerbread, apricot, and honeysuckle, with a long, elegant finish.

- 225 CHENIN BLANC, FAIRVIEW, PAARL. 2023 £42
A fresh, lively perfume of ripe pears and honeysuckle, rich and rounded, with a crisp finish.
- 226 THE UNDERWORLD GRENACHE BLANC, PERDEBERG WINERY, PAARL. 2018 £50
On the nose, citrus fruit and white flowers. Delightful fruitiness on the palate supported by balanced acidity and structure.
- 227 BABY BANDITO KEEP ON PUNCHING, CHENIN BLANC, TESTALONGA, CRAIG HAWKINS, SWARTLAND, 2023 £54
Aromas of freshly cut grass, apple and apricot. The palate is crisp with refreshing acidity and notes of lemon and grapefruit.
- 228 THELEMA CHARDONNAY, THELEMA VINEYARDS, STELLENBOSCH, 2018 £80
This Chardonnay is packed full of intense, vibrant fruit, with subtle hints of oak, and notes of butterscotch and lemon zest.

This Chardonnay is packed full of intense, vibrant fruit, with subtle hints of oak, and notes of butterscotch and lemon zest.

- 253 CHATEAU MUSAR WHITE, BEKA'A VALLEY, SERGE HOCHAR, GAZIR. 2018 £114
Blend of indigenous Lebanese grapes, thought to be similar to Chardonnay and Semillon. Lemon-gold in colour, flavours of lemon, lime, oregano, pine and dried herbs. 9 months oak.

- 254 PAPARUDA FETEASCA REGALA, ESTATE SELECTION, RECAS, ROMANIA, 2024 £36
Aromatic nose with distinct peach and apricot flavours on the palate, soft and creamy fruit and good dry finish.
- 255 TOKAJI DRY FURMINT, OKAJ-HETSZOLO ZRT, TOKAJI, HUNGARY. 2021 £43
Intense, fruity, beautiful nose. The palate is very fresh with lime, pear, green apple, with elegant acidity and minerality.

SLOVAKIA

- 256 RICHARD CHARDONNAY, ZSOLT SUTO 1075, STREKOV. 2022 £59
A very elegant unfiltered wine, with a bold mouthfeel. Ripe peach, apricot and tangerine, with hints of brioche and almond, and well-integrated oak showing.
- 257 RIZLING, ZSOLT SUTO, STREKOV 1075. 2021 £68
Bursting with green and yellow apple, pear and stone fruit, counteracted with a light Creaminess, peach yoghurt feel, from its lees aging, and a touch of hazelnut. Unfiltered/unfined.

U.S.A

- 275 CHARDONNAY, RODNEY STRONG VINEYARDS, HEALDSBURG, CALIFORNIA. 2020 £62
Bright lemon and apple aromas mingle with hints of toasty barrel complexity. On the palate, pear and pineapple with spice and refreshing acidity.
- 276 SMITHEREENS, SKINNER VINEYARDS, EL DORADO, CALIFORNIA. 2017 £64
Predominantly Grenache Blanc, with a blend of Viognier, Roussanne and Marsanne. Aromatic with citrus peel and floral notes. On the palate, rich but balanced with bright acidity, tropical fruit and spice.
- 278 MELON BLANC, BOW & ARROW WINES, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, PORTLAND, OREGAN. £66
2020
Fresh, mineral, flinty and sea air scents leading to a more complex palate of lemongrass, melon, lime and pear with hints of brioche characteristics. Vibrant and mouthwatering palate with fine intensity and length. Lightly filtered.

SOUTH AMERICA

- 300 CATENA 'ALTA' CHARDONNAY, BODEGA CATENA ZAPATA, MENDOZA, £73
ARGENTINA. 2015
An excellent mixture of citrus fruit interwoven with honeyed stone fruit notes and floral tones. The mouthfeel is rich, concentrated pear, apple, apricot, and nutmeg spice.

NEW ZEALAND

- 325 RIESLING, WILD EARTH, CENTRAL OTAGO. 2018 £52
Vibrant citrus on the nose with stonefruit and floral notes. A dry style wine with medium weight and crisp, balanced acidity with a lovely lingering finish.
- 326 'PGR', YEALNADS ESTATE, MARLBOROUGH. 2019 £74
A blend of Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer and Riesling. Beautiful aromas of pear, melon, and lime. Light bodied, but with a real succulent full palate.

AUSTRALIA

- 328 THREE LIONS' CHARDONNAY, PLANTAGENET, WESTERN AUSTRALIA. 2022 £47
Bursting with stone fruit and lemon blossom aromas. Lively palate of grapefruit and lemon meringue, balanced by a subtle richness, cool climate acidity bringing length.
- 330 MOUNT BAKER ESTATE CHARDONNAY, FORREST HILL VINEYARD, WESTERN AUSTRALIA. 2021 £58
Pronounced yellow orchard fruit both on the nose and the palate, with bright mineral notes and nutty nuances, and a beautiful lingering finish.
- 331 GEORGIA'S PADDOCK RIESLING, LAUGHTON FAMILY VINEYARDS, JASPER HILL, VICTOIRA. 2023 £85
Attractive straw coloured with a zesty lime bouquet and a tangy palate of white currant, nectarine, orange, and saffron. Bold and mouth filling, with a creamy texture, and long finish.
- 332 STARGAZER CHARDONNAY, STARGAZER WINES, NORTH HOBART, TASMANIA. 2018 £89
Grapefruit and peaches on the nose. The palate is fine and elegant, with a crisp acidity that is complemented by creamy fruit intensity. Delightful complexity and depth showcasing the wild ferment used.

ORANGE

Orange wine or 'skin contact' as its formal term, may seem a new trend on wine lists and wine shops, but this method has been practiced for thousands of years in countries such as Georgia and Italy. The colour of wine comes from the skins of the grapes, whereby the juice must be left in contact with the skins for a period of time. In white wine making, no skins are permitted to be used, except when the wine becomes named 'skin contact'. This is the same process as white wine making, but the juice then spends a period of time on the skins of the white grapes. This process gives more texture to the wine, along with additional flavours, and also tannins from the skins.
