Château de Poyet, Loire Valley, France  
Extended lees ageing gives this wine added depth and complexity, making it an ideal partner to seafood.
- 31 POUILLY FUMÉ 2010 28.50**  
Cedric Bardin, Pouilly sur Loire, France  
Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grown on Kimmeridgian clay, (named after the village of Kimmeridge in Dorset which has the same soil!). This soil gives the wine a typical gun flint nose and flavour. It is clean, fresh and fruitily dry.
- 32 MENETOU-SALON "CUVEE BEATRICE" 2010 29.50**  
Henry Pelle, Morogues, Loire, France  
Crisp, zingy and fresh with delicious gooseberry, lime and mineral notes.
- 33 SANCERRE BLANC PMG 2010 32.00**  
Gérard Morin, Bué, Loire, France  
The Sancerres from the commune of Bué have the reputation of being rich and full and Gérard's are no exception. PMG means "pour ma gueule" - For my mouth.
- 34 SAVENNIERES "CLOS DU PAPILLON" 2006 45.00**  
Domaine du Closel, Savennieres, Loire, France  
An extremely elegant dry Savennières whose originality comes from a geological spot where the complex variety of rocks produces a wine with lingering fragrance, extremely mineral, with aromas of smoked, roasted almonds, apricot, white flowers. The epitome of dry Chenin.

A nose of white flowers, peach, pear and apricot, the mouth is intense, round, softly structured and lightly perfumed with mineral notes. The finish is elegant with citrus notes.

 Jean-Claude Boisset, Nuits-St-Georges, Burgundy, France  
 From one of Burgundy's most underrated villages. Light gold with green hints, floral and lemony on the nose. The palate shows yellow fruits and honey, with a nice weight for the Côte Chalonnaise. Smooth with subtle vanilla flavours on the long, fresh finish.
- 45 MONTAGNY 1er CRU 2008 32.00**  
 Stéphane Aladame, Montagny Les Buxy, Burgundy, France  
 Fresh yet rich, minerally yet biscuity with lovely depth on the palate and a zingy yet creamy character on the finish.
- 46 POUILLY FUISSE "EN CHAMPS ROUX" 2009 34.00**  
 Domaine Des Gerbeaux, Solutr , Burgundy, France  
 Jean-Michel Drouin's judiciously oaked Fuiss  shows what can really be done in this much abused appellation. Assembled from various plots in the communes of both Pouilly and Fuiss , it is a beautifully balanced wine and a model of technical brilliance.

 Domaine Etienne Boileau, Chablis, Burgundy, France  
 Rich, soft, supple aromatic and complex - perfect traditional Chablis
- 48 SAINT AUBIN 1er CRU VIEILLES VIGNES 2008 43.00**  
 Domaine Larue, Saint-Aubin, Burgundy, France  
 This wine gleams with green highlights, the bouquet has a marked gunflint minerality and the mouth reveals lasting structure. This is a wine of real character.
- 49 MEURSAULT "LIMOZIN" 2007 70.00**  
 Domaine Henri Germain, Meursault, Burgundy, France  
 Serious wine from a serious grower. Elegant and stylish with buttery fruit and a long aftertaste.

 Domaine Henri Germain, Meursault, Burgundy, France  
 Another great wine from Henri Germain - one of the most reliable growers in Burgundy.

Medium dry white wine going brilliantly with richer dishes. Makes a fine aperitif, too.

Domaine Albert Mann, Wettolsheim, Alsace, France  
As you sip this you have the feeling that you are crunching the grapes. The freshness and the touch of bitterness contribute to the spontaneity and the harmony of the wine. With food or ideal as an aperitif.
- 62 RIESLING RÉSERVE 2009** **36.00**  
F.E. Trimbach, Ribeauvillé, Alsace, France  
White flowers, lemon notes and a mineral touch on the nose. Fresh and vibrant with a long finish.
- 63 GEWURZTRAMINER GRAND CRU STEINERT 2004** **38.00**  
Domaine Joseph Rieflé, Pfaffenheim, Alsace, France  
A very fine example of Gewurztraminer with big sweetish fruit and a dry finish.

Made from Sauvignon Blanc and a touch of Sémillon, it is a crisp and delicious dry white, full of upfront fruit with plenty of weight in the mouth.

Bordeaux Blanc A.C.  
Simonette Blech, the daughter of my culinary mentor, Sonia Blech, produces this wine from Sauvignon Blanc, Sauvignon Gris, Sémillon and Muscadelle grapes. Its aromas of white flowers, exotic fruits and minerals introduce a round and fresh palate.

Bordeaux Blanc A.C.  
Only ten barrels are made each year – but the result? A massive, broadly structured, multi-layered and atypical dry white wine with great minerality, length and individuality.

## RHONE

- 80 CROZES HERMITAGE BLANC LA MATINIERE 2008** **27.00**  
Ferraton Père et Fils, Tain l'Hermitage, Rhône, France  
The Ferraton Estate is jointly owned by Samuel Ferraton and Michel Chapoutier. The Chapoutier involvement (since 1998) has greatly benefitted the estate and this wine is an excellent example of a Marsanne and Roussanne blend with fruity and spicy overtones.
- 81 COUDOULET DE BEAUCASTEL 2008** **40.00**  
Château de Beaucastel, Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône, France  
Peaches and honey on the nose, rounded, rich and full bodied on the palate with a balanced freshness and floral notes.
- 82 CONDRIEU "CHÉRY" 2008** **60.00**  
André Perret, Chavanay, Rhône, France  
Golden yellow, this wine balances elegance with power. A bouquet of citrus fruits, violets, apricots and peaches. On the palate an intensity of fruit with a full body, zesty acidity and a very long finish.

Domaine Les Montarels - Côtes de Thongue, France  
Richly fragrant aromas of apricot and white peach with full body and a little weight. Wonderful spicy fruit, pear and honey, a little richness but with zest and lovely acidity.
- 91 COSTIERES DE NIMES "LES GALETS DORÉS" 2009 26.00**  
Château Mourgues du Gres, Beaucaire, Languedoc, France  
Citrus flavours mingled with floral aromas, crisp, fresh and full, the perfect balance between fruit, smooth texture and mineral finish.
- 92 JURANÇON SEC 2008 28.00**  
Domaine de Nays-Labassère, South West France  
Impressions of citrus fruits, white blossom, gingerbread and a hint of smoke. It has a firm attack on the palate with a lively minerality, balance and a good finish.

Deltetto Az. Ag. Canale, Piemonte, Italy  
Soft and well-balanced, an attractive and aromatic nose with vanilla, apple and exotic fruit notes. Fresh, clean and elegant on the palate with good length and a crisp, floral finish.
- 104 GAVI DI GAVI "VIGNETI LUGARARA" 2010 30.00**  
La Giustiniana, Rovereto di Gavi, Piemonte, Italy  
A scent of green apples, balanced acidity and richness on the palate, coupled with a crisp finish makes this a most appealing wine.
- 105 MIDOLINI ROSACROCE CHARDONNAY 2006 32.00**  
Midolini Az. Ag. Fruili, Italy  
Aromas of stone fruit - on the palate attractive citrus fruit with overtones of asparagus and pea shoots. Nice acidity and a good finish.

Floral perfumes and notes of tropical and citrus fruit. On the palate, it is full and ripe, lifted on the finish by a fresh, nicely balanced acidity with a touch of vanilla and cinnamon.
